Extended Schools Provisions

Please note, **clubs are not on in the last week of term**. However, hockey will continue into the last week of the spring term - this is because a week was missed earlier in the term.

The clubs booking system for summer 2018 will be live on the school website from 9.00am Monday morning; payments can be made to secure booked places at the school office or via the school's online payment system from Monday afternoon. Travel and Road Safety

To overcome the congestion of parking outside the school in the mornings and afternoons we are looking at launching a **Park and Stride** scheme in April. Brockenhurst Village Hall have been really kind in agreeing to let parents park in the Village Hall car park and then for parents to walk the children to and from school. To be able to do this you will be asked to sign an agreement that you will only use the facility for drop-off and collection. Once you have signed the agreement you will be given a car sticker to show you have permission to park in the Village Hall car park. If a car is found using the car park without a Park and Stride sticker, the Village Hall will have the right to fine or clamp.



We are also starting our **Walk Once a Week (Wow)** campaign after Easter. During the Parents Evenings next week there will be a stand manned by Amy from Living Streets who will be there to answer questions and promote the scheme. www.livingstreets.org.uk/what-we-do/projects/wow-app

Both the Park and Stride and WoW schemes are endorsed by Hampshire County Council and will take us closer to obtaining a Silver Award from the Modeshift Stars campaign (Sustainable Travel Accreditation and Recognition Scheme).
