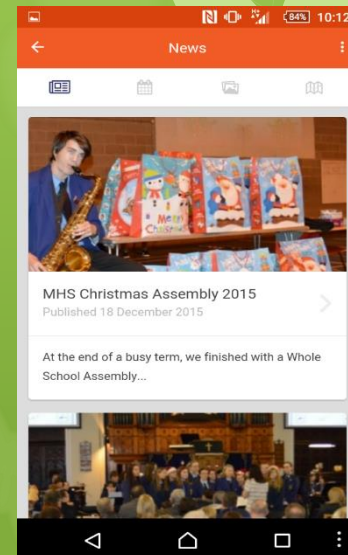
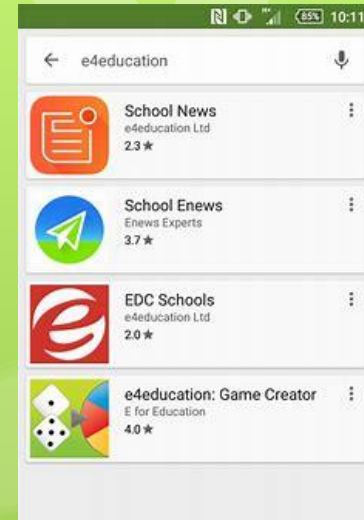

Summer Term Induction

Meeting each other – All children are special – Our induction is strong

Preparing your child for school

Independent behaviours – let your child do things for themselves – give them opportunities to learn about all sort of things between now and September i.e.

- Recognise their own name
- Listen to an instruction - practise one part or two part or three part instructions
- Read to your child every evening and ASK questions about the text.
- Encourage an awareness of letters and numbers
- Take turns in games
- Concentrate on a task and stick to something for about 5 minutes
- Manage their bags, carrying objects and resilience with walking
- Independent eating :- Use a knife and fork eat / eat fruit snack only – no chocolate or nuts or sweets / Use the toilet and manage their underwear.
- Dress and undress
