Head Lice and threadworms

We have had a number of parents contacting the school regarding problems with head-lice. Please ensure you check your child's hair weekly and if you find your child has head lice that they are treated accordingly. If you need advice, please ask your local pharmacist.

Threadworms are extremely common in children, but fairly harmless and easy to get rid of. Infected children scratch their bottoms, trap the eggs under the fingernails and can pass the eggs on their hands. If your child then swallows eggs they'll become infected. A treatment drink from your pharmacy will successfully treat threadworms. Make sure the whole family takes it.
