THINK Zig-Zags

Don't park on the Zig-Zags!
Keep school entrance clear.

REMEMBER

The **Zig-Zags** are there for a purpose – to provide a clear area in which children can cross. They can see approaching cars and drivers can see them.



Unlike adults young children cannot see over parked vehicles, likewise drivers cannot necessarily children.

A clear space is essential for the children to see traffic easily and for drivers to be able to see them. Yellow Zig-Zag markings outside schools are there to provide a clear area in which children can cross the road safely.



South Famborough Junior School asked their pupils to design posters asking drivers to park elsewhere.
