How children are selected for sporting events at Brockenhurst Primary.

Here at Brockenhurst, we offer a lot of sports based clubs. It gives us a great platform for choosing students to compete for the school. Firstly, if we could, we would choose all children who wanted to attend sports competitions. Sadly, due to participation rules, transport logistics, teacher cover costs and extra adult support, we can't always do this. We choose children who we feel will represent the school competitively but also children who show our school values of thankful, hopeful and loving. Sometimes we have mores students in clubs than competitions, here we try to be as fair as possible and sometimes select children who have not always had an opportunity to represent the school. If we know children are competitive at sports outside of school, we may give them the opportunity to represent the school. Also if we think children need encouraging in school, we may pick them to attend a sport competition that they have played in before. All in all we aim to be as fair and rounded as possible.

Please can you ensure they arrive promptly at 08:00 for the start of the club. Staff can only man the gate for a five minute window as they are required to run the club and supervise the children attending. Late arrival disrupts the time used to warm up and valuable initial instruction. It also impacts the length and flow of the club as staff have to stop what they are doing in order to engage with the late parent and child. We respectfully ask for your support in this matter.
