### **History Morning**

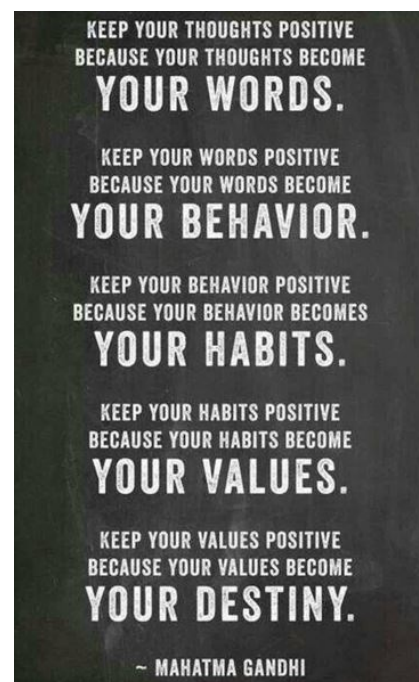

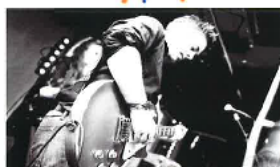
### The Beginners Guitar Experience
