Since 1996, the Honeypot Children's Charity has been working to enhance the lives of young carers and vulnerable children aged five to 12 years by providing residential respite breaks at Honeypot House in the New Forest and on-going outreach support. Each year, Honeypot supports over 1000 children from across the UK. Most are young carers who juggle their education alongside performing a surrogate adult role at home. Many care for a chronically or terminally ill loved one, or have a parent with drug, alcohol or mental health issues. Some will have been in a caring role from as young as 5 years old, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Honeypot offers a programme of long term, personalised and consistent support that gives hope and encouragement to these children. This includes an annual respite break, birthday cards, Christmas presents and three visits from the Honeypot Playbus each year. The children take a break from their caring responsibilities, build strong friendships and create lasting memories that they can cherish for years.
