

Krishna fights the Serpent King (pages 14–15)

- 1 2a – 1 mark. He ruled/ governed/ reigned/ controlled.
- 2 2f – 1 mark. To show the power and size of the serpent./To describe the size and scale of the destruction and devastation he can cause.
- 3 a) 2g – 1 mark – *a simile*.
b) 2g – 1 mark for answers about it showing that Kaliya is in pain/under pressure/being overwhelmed by the huge power of Krishna.
- 4 2b – 1 mark for all correctly ordered:
Krishna landed on the heads of the serpent. 4
Krishna's friends were drowned. 3
Kaliya killed the blacksmith's son. 2
The serpent burnt the countryside. 1
Kaliya returned to his court. 5
- 5 2h – 1 mark for answers relating to what Kaliya or Krishna will do: Kaliya will drag Krishna below the water and try to drown him in his whirlpool home, hoping that Krishna won't be able to breathe./Kaliya will rise up, shooting flames around Krishna before dragging him below the water./Krishna will summon all his courage and powers and defeat the serpent.
- 6 2d – 1 mark for any of the following: Kaliya felt as if all the mountains of the Himalayas were raining on his head./Krishna crushed one of Kaliya's heads under one arm and another head under another arm./He danced on the remaining three heads./Krishna defeated Kaliya.
