

This means you could look at a picture of a landmark and know straight away where it is.




The Sahara Desert



Maasai Mara



Timgad Ruins


The Timgad ruins are what is left of a Roman city built almost two thousand years ago. The ruins are in Algeria in


locally as 'Mosi-oa-Tunya' which means 'the smoke that thunders'.
