Maths	45 mins	<p>L.O: To subtract a two digit number.</p> <p>Complete the attached sheet on subtraction. Remember when we subtract our answer is smaller than the whole amount that we started with. Use your knowledge of tens and ones to work out the answer and draw pictures to help you.</p> <p>When solving the last problem please explain how you worked the answer out and record it as a bar model or part whole model.</p>
Spelling	15 mins	<p>Practise your spellings on Spelling Shed.</p> <p>This week we will be working on some of our common exception words. Make sure you practise reading them too!</p> <p>Whole Any Many Clothes Busy People Water Again Half Money</p>
Reading	15 mins	<p>Read your reading book (or one from Oxford Owl). Re-read any parts that don't quite make sense.</p> <p>Tell someone in your house what the story was about. Were there any parts you did not like? What was your favourite part?</p>
