Children identify the coins to work out how much is used to pay. They use subtraction to find the amount of change. They need to know that £1 = 100p and use this information to find change when £1 is paid. They can also use number bonds to 100 to help with this.

How many pence are in £1?

In your calculation will you write £1 – 98p or 100p – 98p? Why?

How much was paid by Anna?

How do you know?

What subtraction calculation should we write?

Which number goes first?

Why?

What method will you use to find the answer?

Is that an efficient method?
