



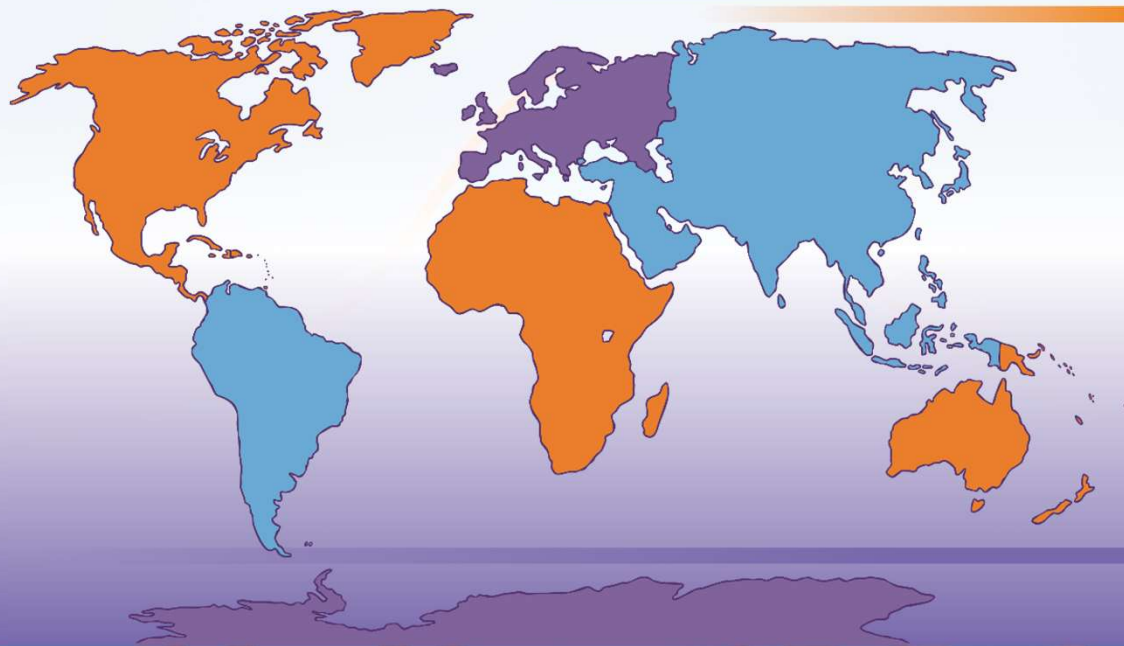

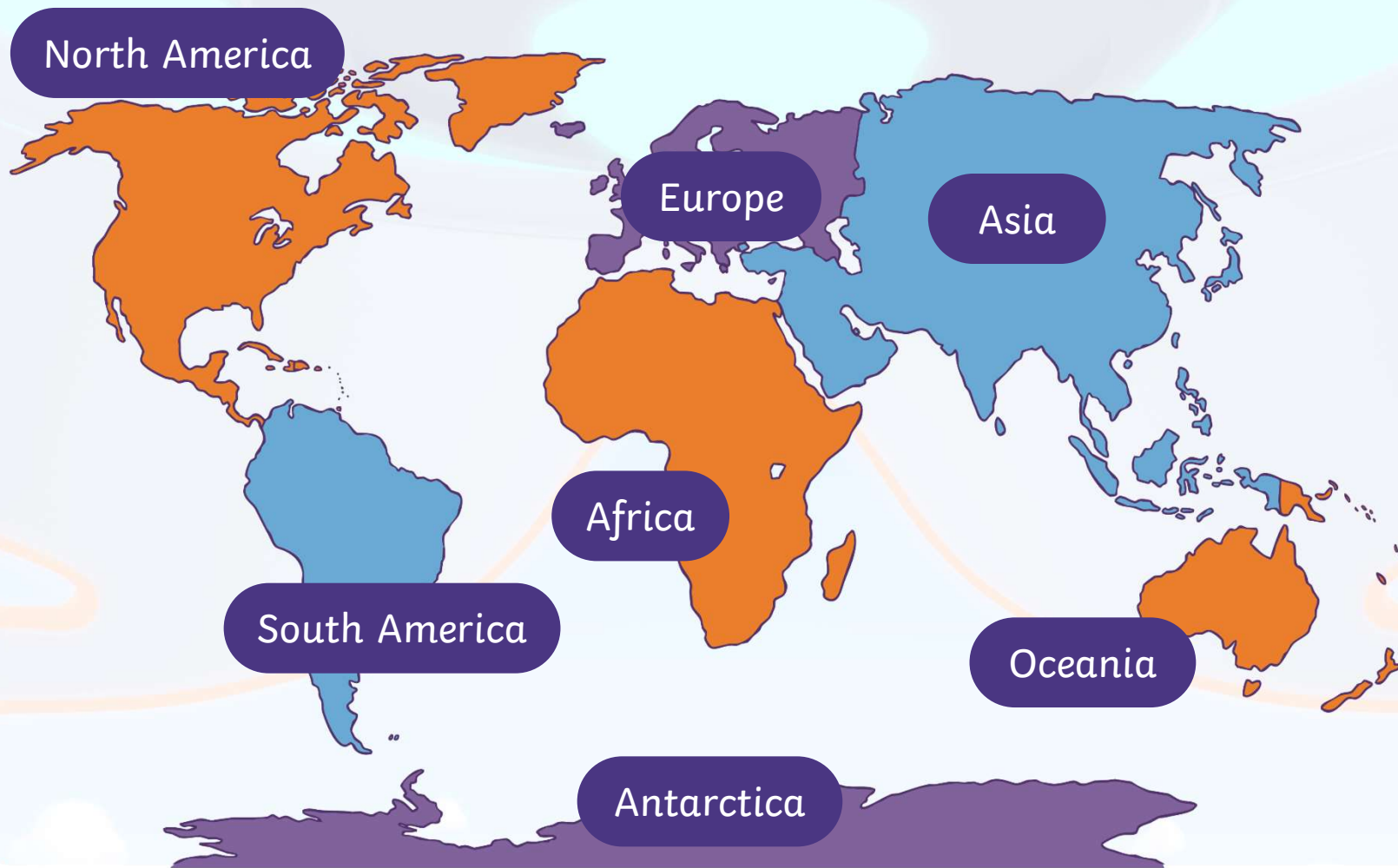
What Is a Continent?

Brandenburg Gate

Here's Ubercorn with some funky facts.



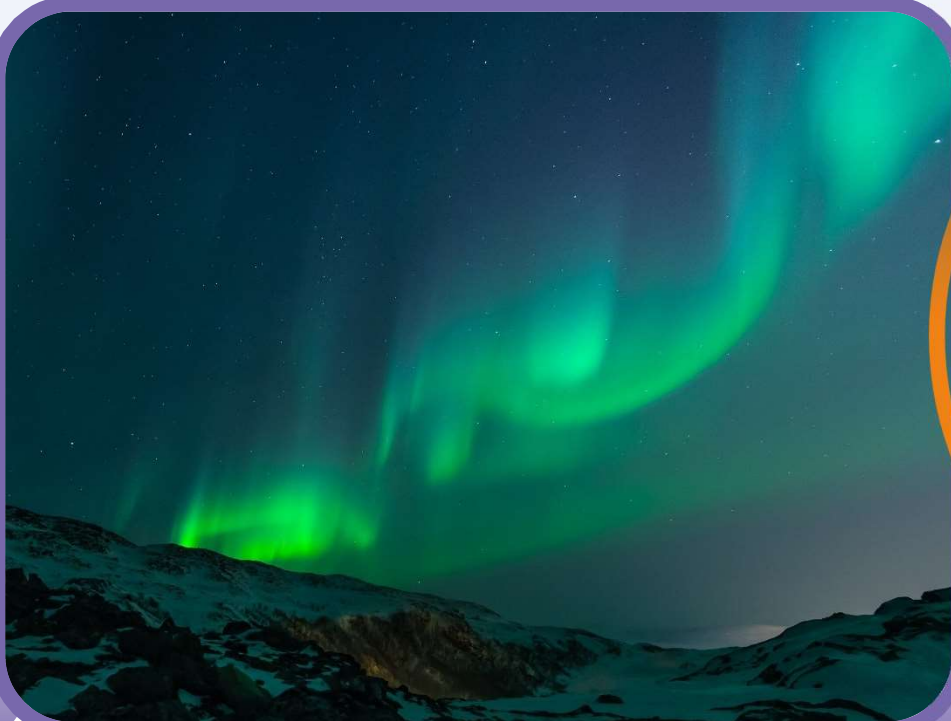
The Acropolis
