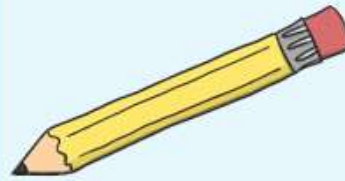


# What is a noun?

A noun is a naming word.

pencil



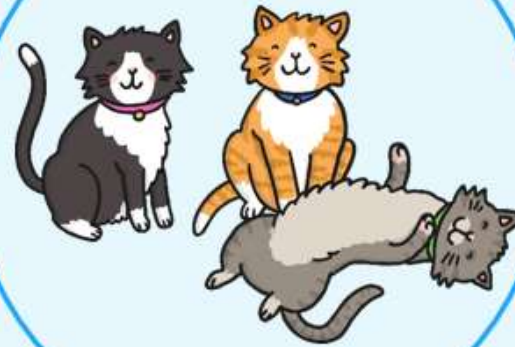
cat

# What is a plural?

Plural means 'more than one'.



one cat



three cats

Singular = 1

One dog

One door

One pencil

One lamp

Singular = 1

Plural = more than 1

One dog



Lots of dogs

One door



Lots of doors

One pencil



Lots of pencils

One lamp

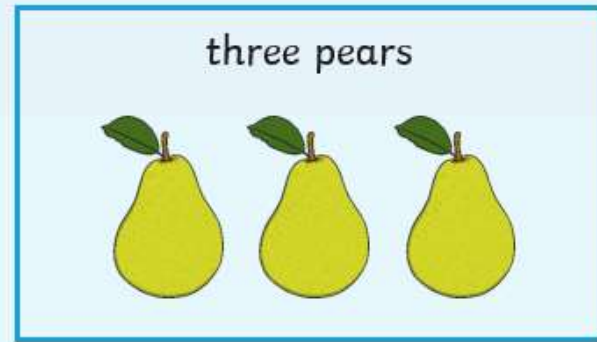
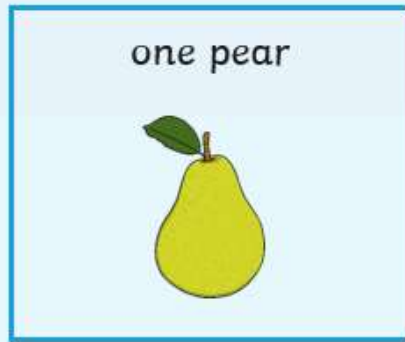


Lots of lamps

Are these words all correct?

For most words we just add 's' to the end of it to change it into a plural.



desk → desks

month → months

book → books

train → trains

pen → pens

dog → dogs

If the word ends with one of these sounds...

sh

ch

ss

s

x

z

...then add 'es'
