5. Have a look at the days of the week. One is missing from this sequence. Which day is missing?

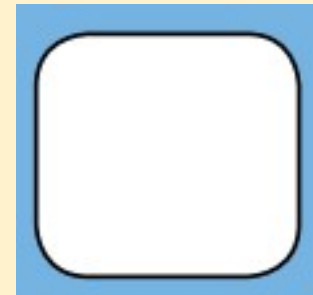
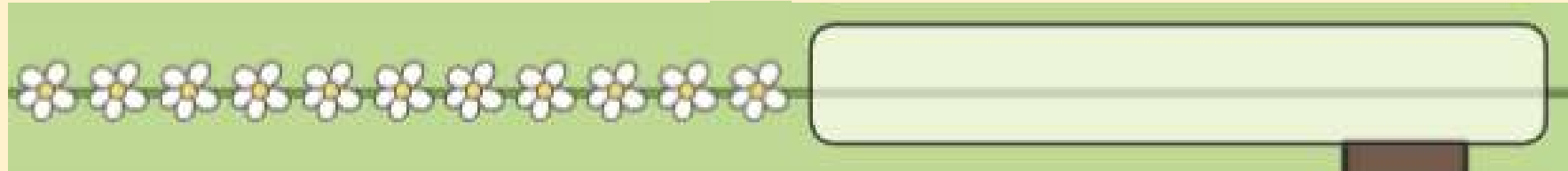

6. There are 12 strawberries and 9 pears in the bowl. How many pieces of fruit are in the bowl altogether?

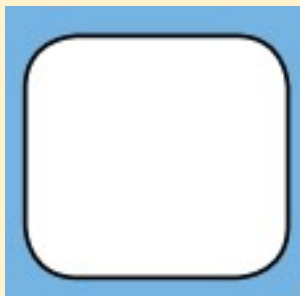




7. I would like 20 daisies in my daisy chain. I have already picked some. Can you add some more to give me a total of 20?
