Please could you remind those who drop their children off at your school that it is in fact illegal to drive on pavements, and with good reason. I have also had previous encounters with parents conducting rapid three point turns in the same road, dangerously mounting the pavement. It is especially hard to see small children walking along that road in between the parked cars, so it is highly irresponsible (and illegal) for drivers to mount the pavement in these ways.
