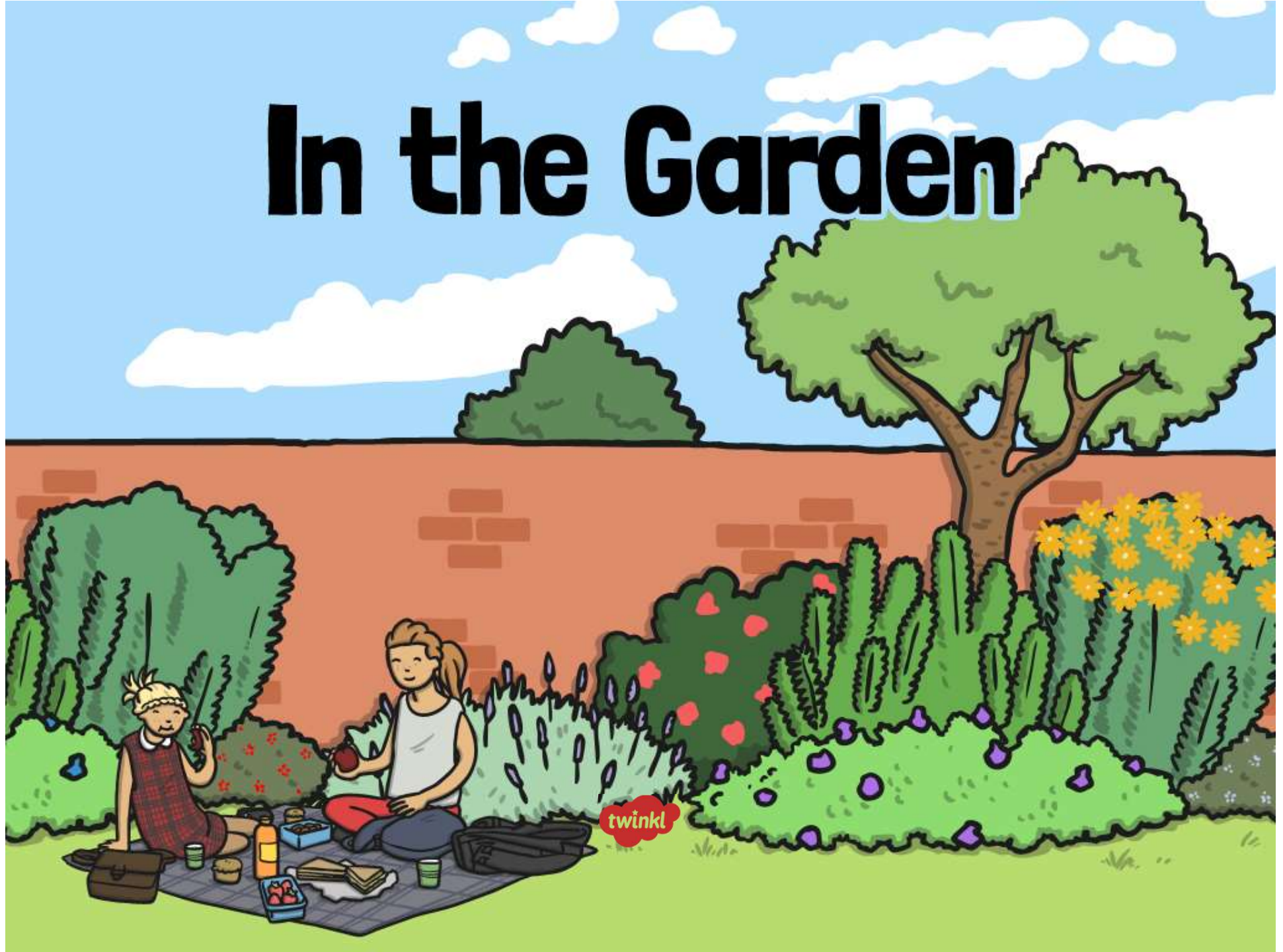



# In the Garden





In our last Science session, we explored Wild Plants that can be found all around our local area.

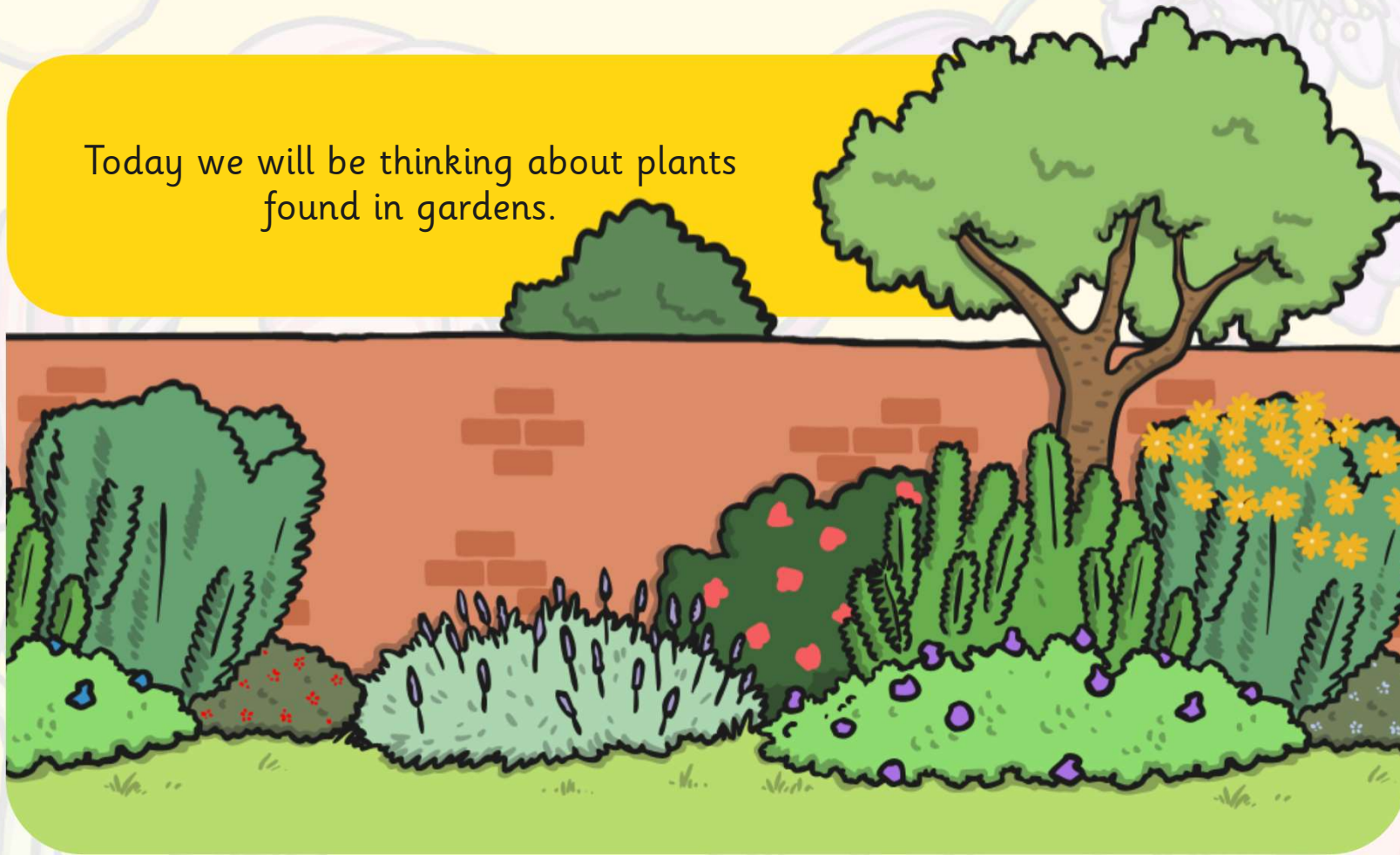
Today, we are going to explore flowers which appear more often in our gardens than around wilder areas. See how many flowers you recognise and see whether they are growing in your gardens.

# Great Gardens

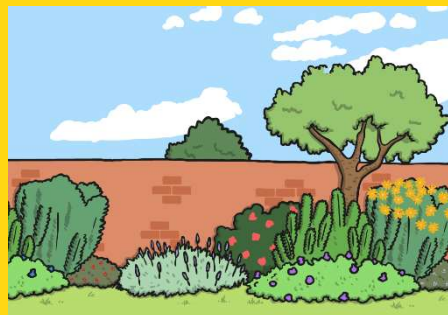
Gardens are places where people grow plants.

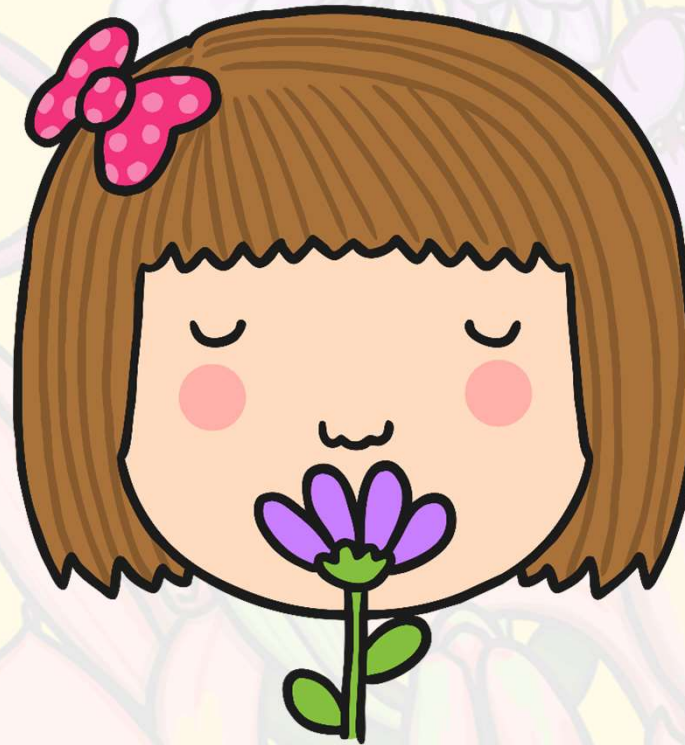

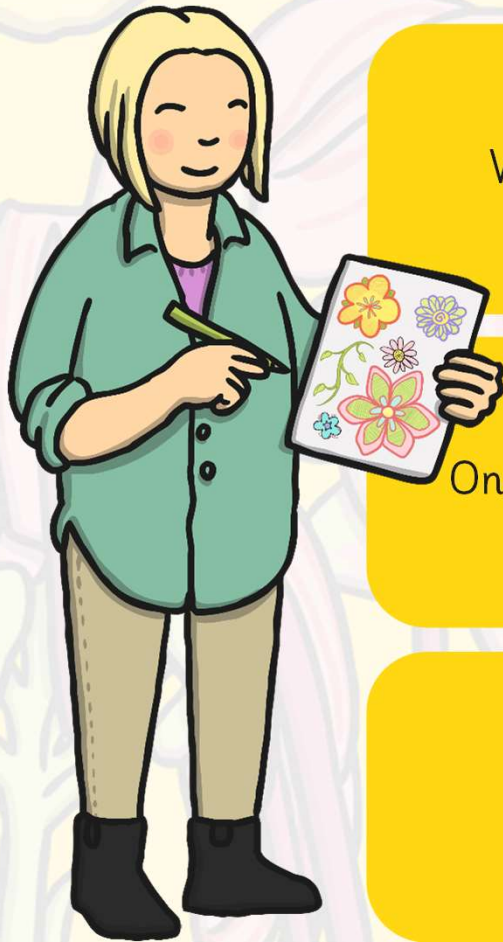
Think of a garden that you like to spend time in.

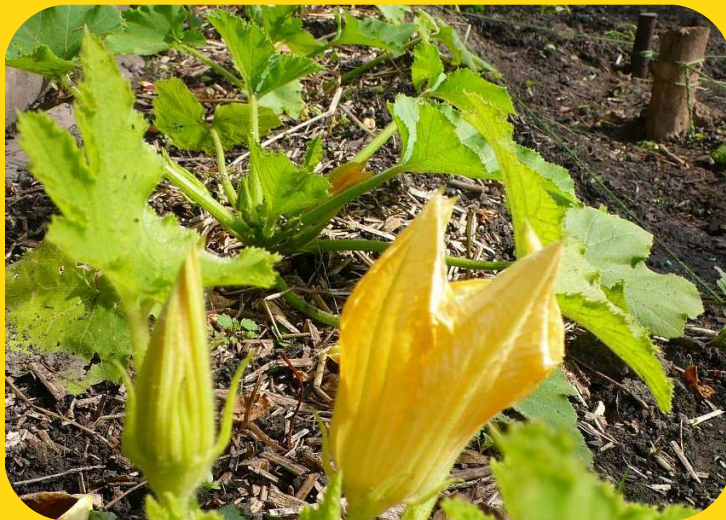

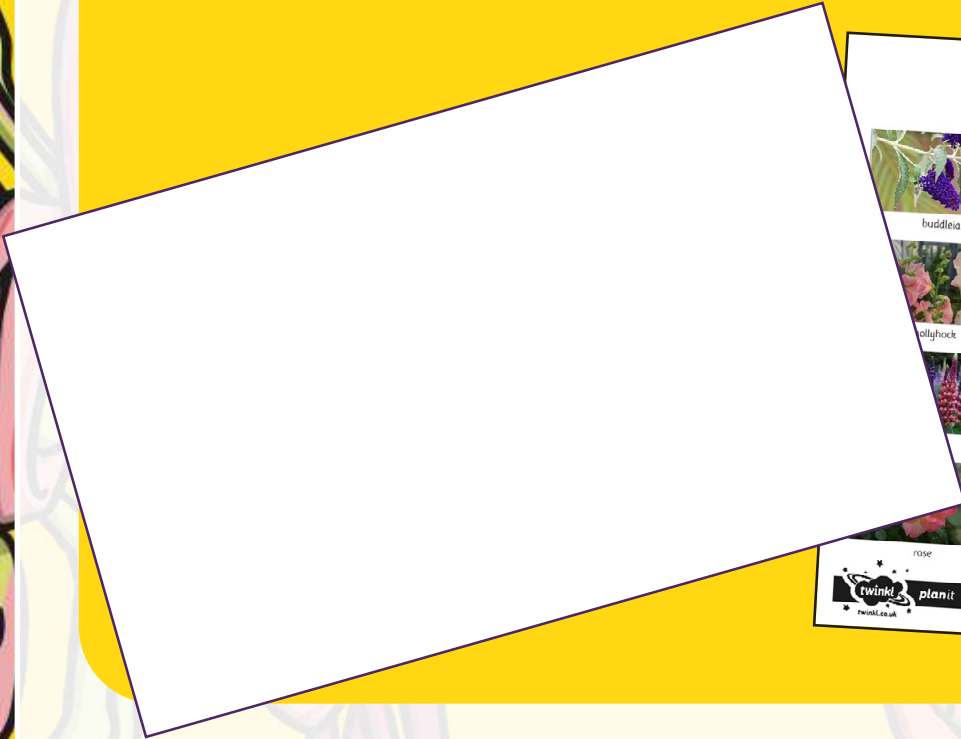
