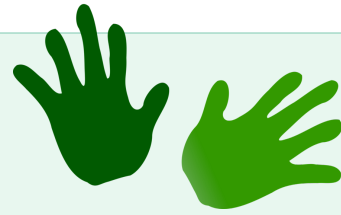


A Bit Stuck? Walk then fly!

Work in pairs

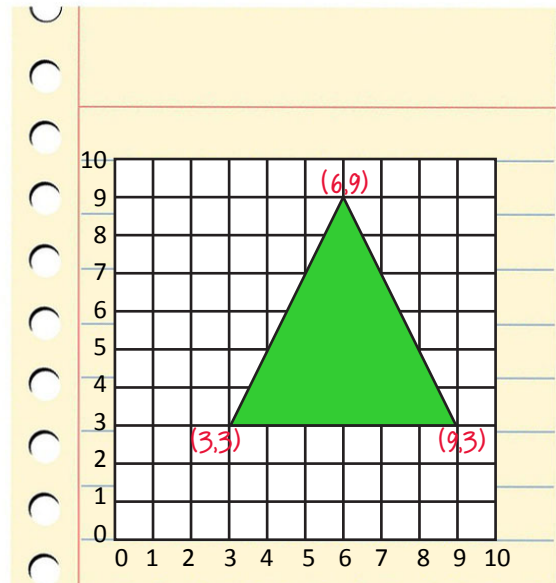
Things you will need:

- A grid
- Coloured pencils



What to do:

- Sit back to back.
- Choose a coloured pencil.
Use it to draw a triangle on your grid.
- Tell your partner the colour pencil you chose.
Call out the co-ordinates of the points of your triangle to your partner.
They draw the points, then join them to make a triangle using the same coloured pencil.
- Now compare your triangles.
Are they the same?
If so, you both score 3 points.
If not, you score 1 point for each matching point.
- Swap roles and repeat using a different coloured pencil.



S-t-r-e-t-c-h:

Move one of your triangles up by two squares. Record the new co-ordinates.

Learning outcomes:

- I can use co-ordinates in the first quadrant.
- I am beginning to work out new co-ordinates after a translation.
