# **Quality of Teaching, Learning and Assessment**

#### **Hooke Court Visit**

Year 4 have had an amazing time at Hooke Court on their residential visit this week learning about Romans. Thank you to Miss Stuttle and her support team for enabling these exciting few days. On the way to Hooke Court the group visited Maiden Castle in Dorchester and had a guided tour of the Roman House. Whilst at Maiden Castle the group were observed by a retired Hampshire Head Teacher who sent us a very complimentary email yesterday:

"The groups were well organised and you could see they were relaxed and happy by the way they walked (I was about 600m above them from the car park). As they passed me, the lead teacher said, 'Sorry to disturb your peace', not knowing I was making notes about their learning journey or that I could possibly have been a teacher myself!

The children were delightful - many saying 'good afternoon' or 'hello' (all without prompting). Congratulations and please pass on my praise to your children and staff.

The route up the castle top was carefully chosen - the children arrived at the top of the first rampart and then looked down unexpectedly into the first deep ditch system. I heard them saying 'wow' and 'oohhh' as they took in the view. I always think it is a wonderful moment when the teacher anticipates exactly the children's reaction, because it is the only reaction, and the teacher has led the child to this moment deliberately because it is good to experience such moments. There were two more such moments up that path still to come - and all dug with deer antlers! Such concepts seem impossible to me."

# **Personal Development, Behaviour and Welfare**

# Be Dog and Horse Wise

Please remind your children that, as tempting as it is for children to pet and embrace dogs or horses at the school gate, it is never wise to pet a dog or horse without its adult owner there. You can never know how an animal will react when approached even if you know them well. Please teach your child never to put their faces down towards the dog's face. There have been many incidents in the media regarding accidents with dogs, so please take care. Injuries from ponies and horses are possible too, especially at the moment as the mares are currently foaling. Not only is there a possibility of biting and kicking, but also treading a heavy hoof on delicate toes. So please always ask the adult in charge, and learn how to stay safe.

#### Sun Safe

We have signed up for Sun Safe Schools Accreditation. We have agreed a policy and have put in place measures to ensure our children have shade during the school day if outside at play. Please may we ask you to read the letter and policy, sign the attached response form and return it to school.

You can help us by sending your child into school with a sun hat and sun-cream to protect them from the harmful UV rays that are prevalent between 11.00am to 3.00pm when the children are often at play outside. Thank you.

Hopefully your children have brought home a small booklet with stickers for 'Walk to School' week next week. We are aware many of you walk, cycle or scoot in already. Please continue to do so.
