

## Answers

$$1. : 3 - \frac{2}{3} = 2\frac{3}{3} - \frac{2}{3}$$

$$= 2\frac{1}{3}$$

Holly has  $2\frac{1}{3}$  pizzas left for her family.

$$2. : 8 - \frac{3}{5} = 7\frac{5}{5} - \frac{3}{5}$$

There are  $7\frac{2}{5}$  pizzas left for Abdul's friends.

$$3.a): 5 - 4\frac{2}{7} = 4\frac{7}{7} - 4\frac{2}{7} = \frac{5}{7}$$

$\frac{5}{7}$  of a cheese and tomato pizza has been eaten.

3.b):  $\frac{5}{7}$  of a pizza has been eaten. This is the same as 5 slices. 2 people can share two slices as:

1 and 4 or 2 and 3.
