What is a suffix?

A **suffix** is a group of letters that can be added on to the end of a **root** word to slightly change its meaning.

e.g. **walking**

Walk is the root word.

ing is the suffix.

Looking at things to find differences and similarities is called **comparing**.
To compare objects, we use **adjectives** to **describe** them.

e.g. small.
