Children should never touch fire or matches. Remember that only adults can use fire or matches.






Rule #2 – Stop, Drop and Roll

Rule #3 – Never Hide During a Fire

Do not hide during a fire.

Always let the firefighters see you by waving your arms and calling out to them.





Rule #4 – Stay Low

During a fire, always remember to stay low on the floor. Get down on all fours and crawl to the nearest exit.



Rule #5 – Get Out and Stay Out

It is important to get out of a burning building quickly and stay Never go back inside of a burning building!



Rule #6 – Have a Family Meeting Place


Your family should have a safe meeting place that is outside and away from the fire. Everyone will meet here in case of a fire.
