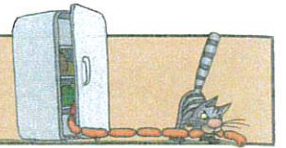


Phrases

(some phrases might have neither).

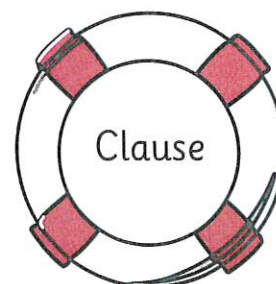
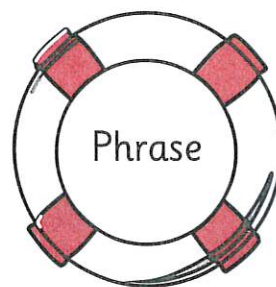
