

## Reading Task - Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> June 2020

Today I would like you to create an emotion graph for our story 'The Lion Inside', like we do in class. Start by re-watching the story. Think about how the mouse might have been feeling at the different points in the story.

- 1) When the mouse is squashed and ignored by the other animals.
- 2) When the mouse first saw the lion.
- 3) When the mouse decides that he's going to learn to roar.
- 4) When the mouse climbs up the rock towards the lion.
- 5) When the mouse becomes friends with the lion and they stay together.

I have attached some emotions for you to choose from, although you might come up with some of your own (you could choose more than one). After you have decided on emotions, I would like you to write in sentences why you decided on those emotions, using 'because'.

E.g. The mouse feels relaxed because he is at home where he is safe and surrounded by all of his lovely things.
