
Phonics – Tuesday 30th June

Page 12: What does Ray offer to do for Kay?


Prove it

Page 15: Why does Kay call her kitten Ray?




To Kay West

Hooray! Today is such a happy day! Thank you so much for finding my Catkin! It's what I was praying for!


But it was a bit of a shock to find the kittens in the box of hay with her - a black kitten and a grey kitten!
