

Spellings dress	Introduction	The /s/ sound is usually spelled with a double s in words that only have one syllable. Get the children to clap each word and see how many syllables each word in the list has, they should notice that the words are single syllable.		
class	Main	Ask the children to copy the words from the spelling list and put


