

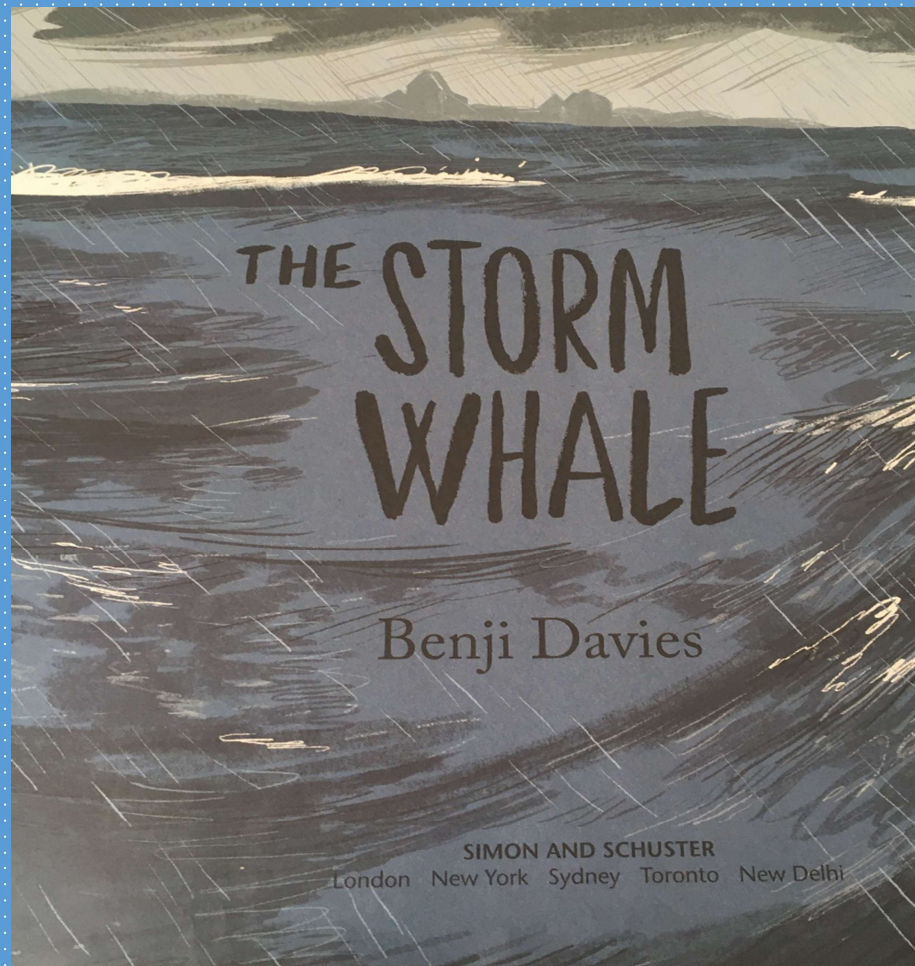

One night, a great storm had raged around their house.

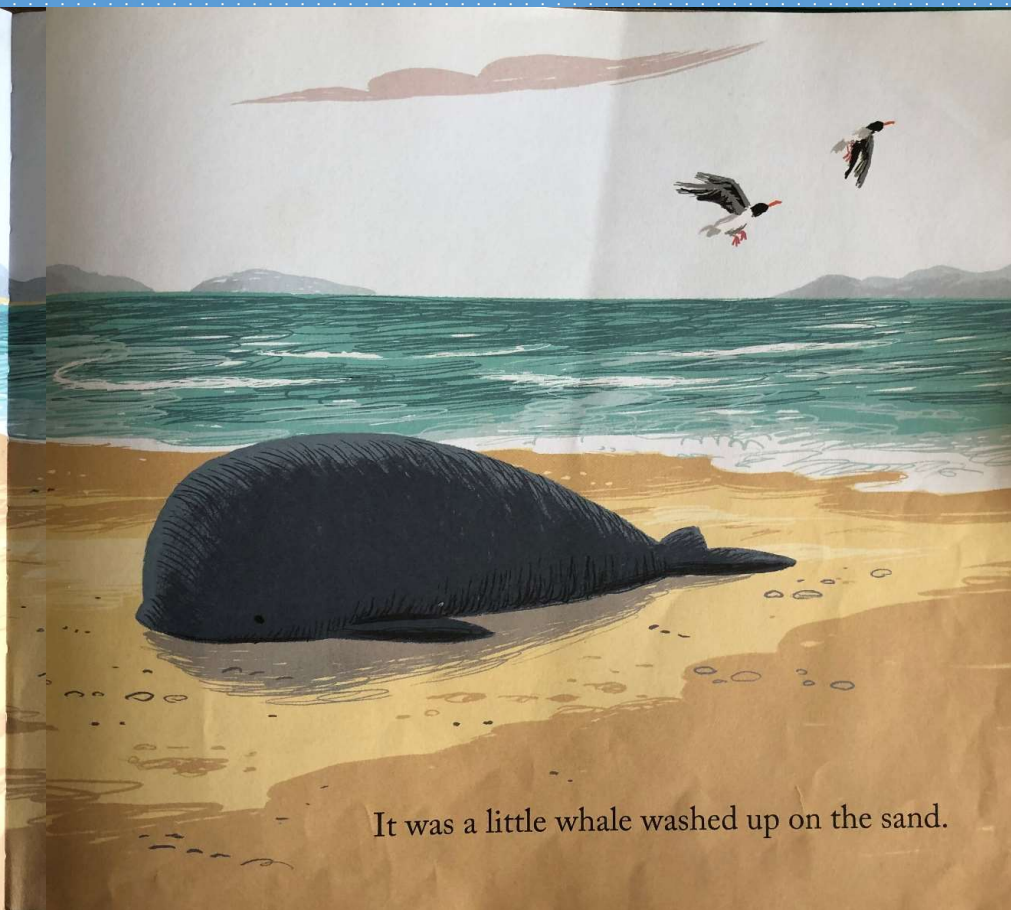
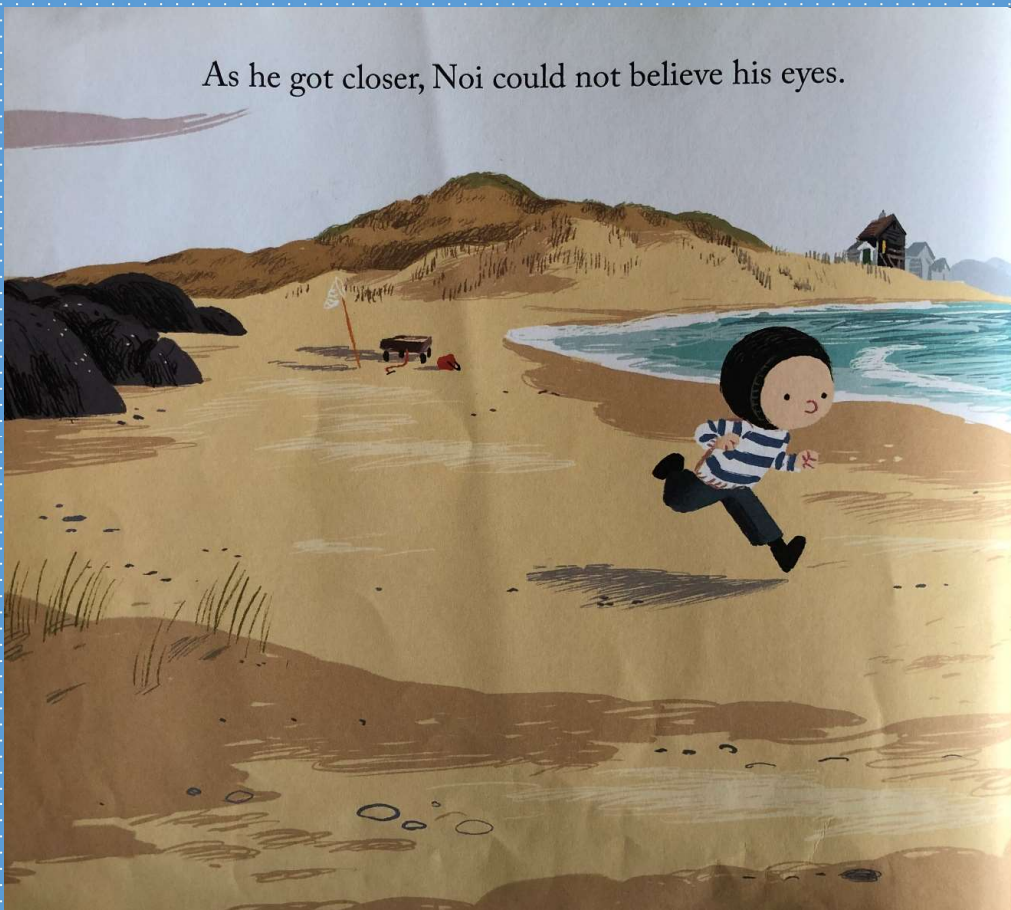

*Today we will be practising saying our sentences out loud in a nice clear voice.*

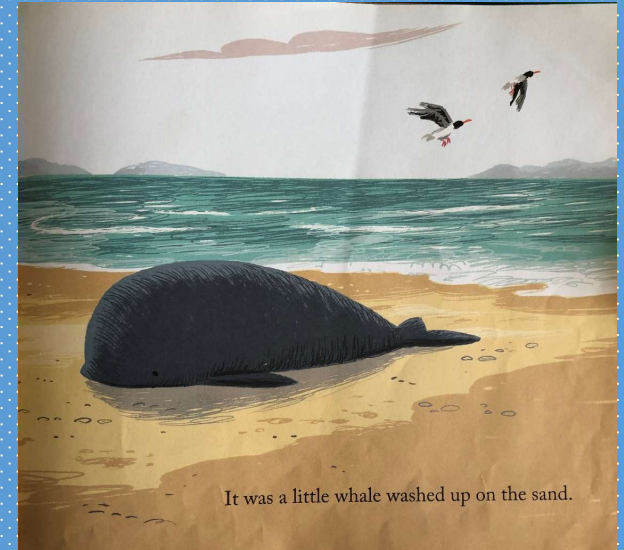
*How does saying our ideas out loud help us?*



*It was a little whale washed up on the sand.*

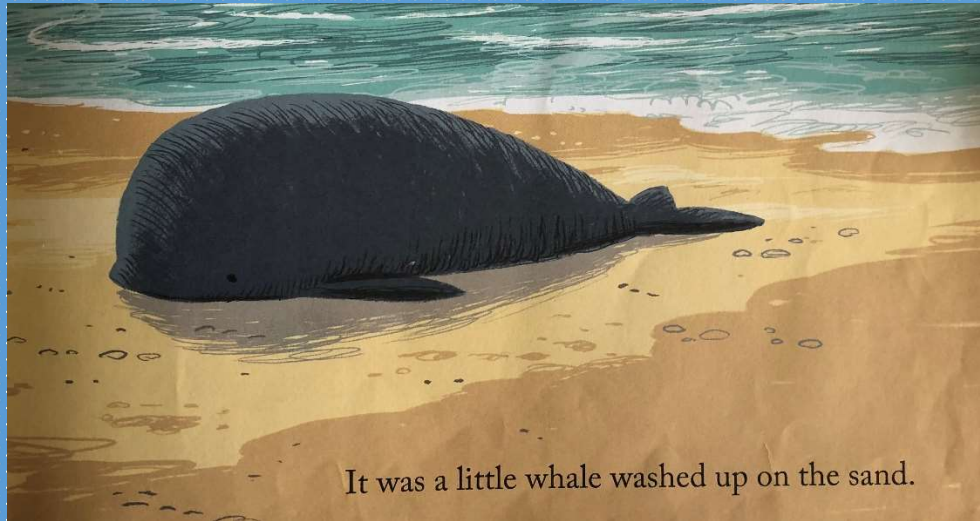


*Saying a sentence out loud helps us to hear the individual words so we know where to put our finger spaces and to make sure that we haven't missed out any words.*

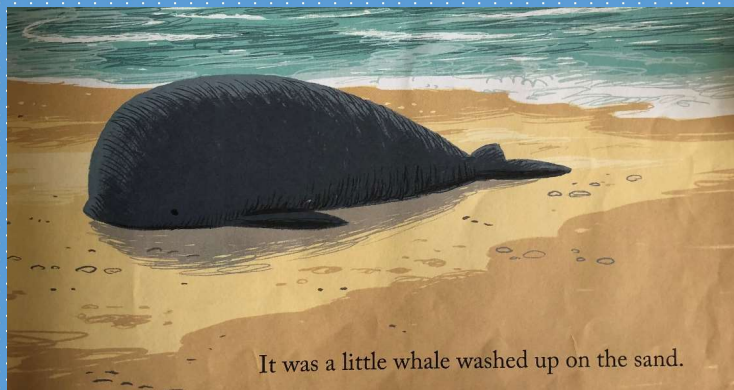

Using 'because' to give our opinion ☐

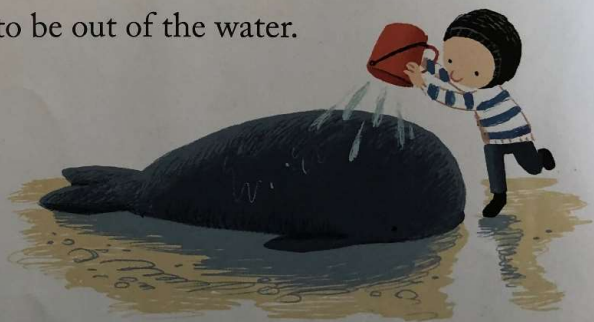

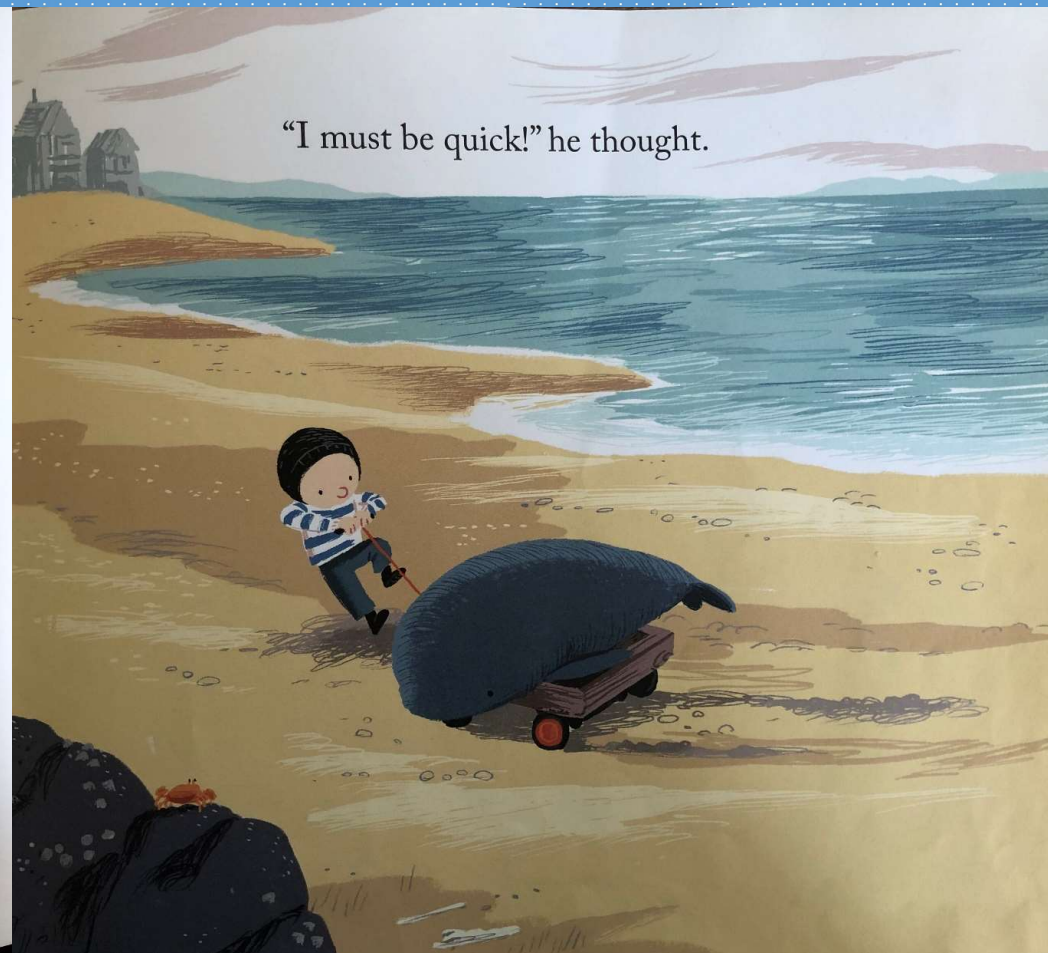
