




1 - Cut some cardboard tubes in half and cut some thin lengths of card like this . . .



you can fold the card in half so that it's equal.

> 2 - Use pieces of the tube to create the basic shape of the aircraft.

7 - Final details, I've made a wheel, guns and extra strips on the wings.
