
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

Every day, Noi's dad left early for a long day's work on his fishing boat.





He wouldn't be home again till dark.


One night, a great storm had raged around their house.


In the morning, Noi went down to the beach to see what had been left behind.






Noi did everything he could to make the whale feel at home.




He told stories about life on the island. The whale was an excellent listener.

Noi was worried that his dad would be angry about having a whale in the bath.




Noi's dad wasn't angry. He had been so busy, he hadn't noticed that Noi was lonely.




But he said they must take the whale back to the sea, where it belonged.

Let's role play the conversation between Noi and his dad.


Think about how they might say things.
