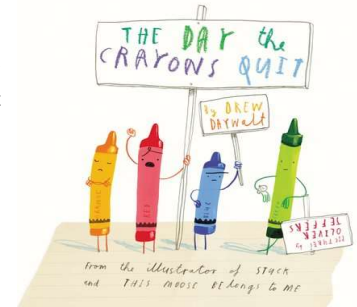


English Task - Friday 17th July 2020

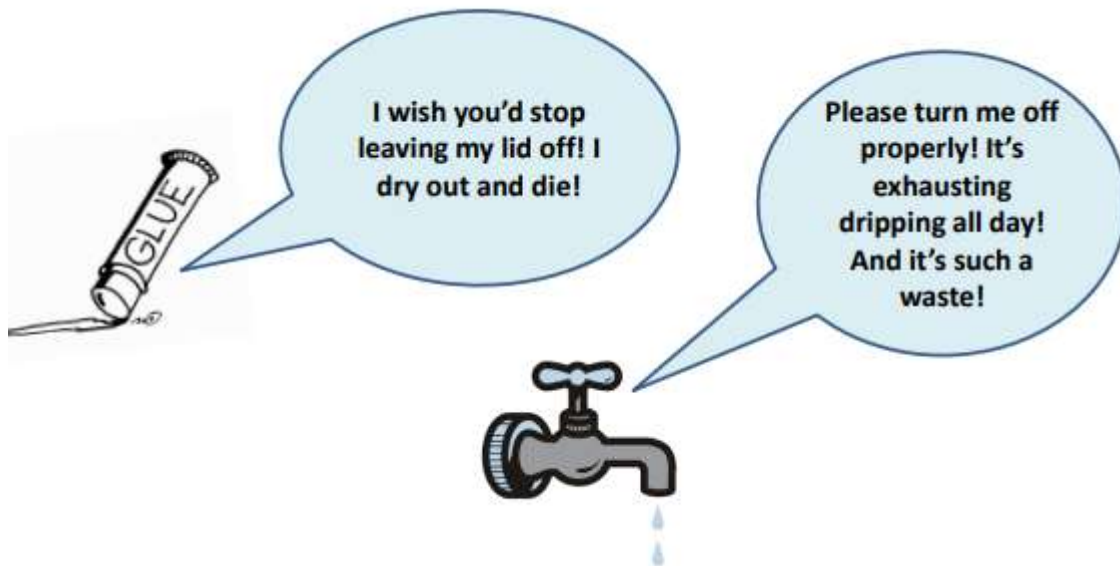
