Hopefully you will also have noticed the Brock Preschool is now on site and open. Melanie Edwards and the Trustees have worked tirelessly with me and the school to make this happen. It fits seamlessly within the site and from Monday Badger's Rest After School Club will be based in there and will dismiss from their door and not the hall. A bell and signage will be on the fence next to the Preschool door. Badger's Rest Breakfast Club will continue in the hall until after half term. Please remember that Badger's Rest is for Preschool and Brockenhurst Primary School children from ages 2 to 11 years old. If you attend the Preschool or the school you are automatically registered and entitled to use us. School Notices:

- <u>Annual Data Collection</u>: Please log onto your SIMS Parent app account to check that your contact details and child's vital information is currently up to date. (Please note we no longer send out paper forms.) If your details change throughout the year you can amend these yourself via the app at any time. If you do not have a SIMS Parent account please contact the office we will need your current email address to activate this for you.
- <u>School lunch price change</u>: HCC have agreed a price increase to school lunches from 1st November 2020. For KS2 this will rise by 10p to £2.50 a day; all KS1 children will still benefit from Universal Free School meals. HC3S, our school lunch providers, have attributed this to the increasing cost of ingredients. They are also looking to source alternatives to singleuse plastic across their operation. - <u>Important Reminder</u>: The deadline for completion of flu immunisation consent forms is today, Friday 2nd October. The school immunisation team will be visiting us on 6th October to administer flu vaccines to all year groups by parental e-consent.
