School Notices:

• **MDSA's needed!** Do you or someone you know have two lunchtimes a week available to be a midday supervisor at school? From 1st September we need cover on a Tuesday and a Wednesday from 12 to 1:15pm. Please let the office know.

• We are pleased to be able to offer **holiday club** for two weeks during the summer holidays: weeks commencing 26th July and 2nd August. You will need to pay and make your booking via your Scopay account even if you expressed your initial interest in a holiday club. The cost of £25 per day includes a morning and afternoon snack; children will need to bring their own packed lunch. The day runs from 8am until 5pm, with drop off between 8-8:30am and pickup between 4:30-5pm. Please note holiday club sessions are nonrefundable. Payment can be made with childcare vouchers. If you would like to use childcare vouchers and have not done so previously, please contact the school office with details of your voucher provider and reference number.

• Breakfast and After School Club bookings can now be made for the autumn term. Breakfast Club costs £4.50 per session including breakfast (for arrivals before 8am). After School Club is £10 per session, which includes a snack. Please book via Scopay in the usual way or contact the office if you would like to arrange payment with childcare vouchers.

• Please would you keep your child's lunch account in credit at all times. We still have a number of accounts which are showing a debit balance; school budgets are unable to carry this cost. You can add any amount of credit to your account – school lunches are currently £2.50 per day.
