Our strategic ambitions for our School and Pre-School 2022-2025.

1. To be the destination school of choice, recognised as offering outstanding provision by all.

We will know we have achieved this by:

- Our pupil numbers will consistently be a minimum of 95% of our published admission number (PAN).
- Staff recruitment data will indicate posts are filled efficiently and effectively and exit interviews of staff indicate they are leaving either for personal reasons or for career development.
- Our staff, pupil and parent surveys indicate positive views of the school.
- Feedback from our community shows the school is active within the wider community.
- We have a broad and balanced curriculum in place, linking with clubs and the wider community.
- Feedback from visitors including Ofsted is positive and reflects our culture and ethos in action.

2. To build community partnerships which enhance the life of the School and Pre-School.

We will know we have achieved this by:

- An increase in the number of volunteers taking part in the life of the School and Pre-School.
- An increase in the number of community groups using the facilities.
- There is a consistent flow of information between the School and Pre-School and the local community and vice versa.

3. Our children are prepared and equipped for the next stages in their lives.

We will know we have achieved this by:

- Our Christian and learning values are embedded in the day to day life of the School and Pre-School.
- Our skills based curriculum developed in line with increasing knowledge is delivered across all ages and phases.
- We can track the outcomes of our pupils who have moved on from us.

4. To form strong partnerships with other schools and education providers.

We will know we have achieved this by:

- New formal and informal arrangements being in place with other schools and education providers that enhance the resources and skills available for our children.
- Governance arrangements are continually reviewed to ensure there is strong and effective leadership in place.
- We both lead and participate in arrangements with others.

- The front entrance to our School and Pre-School is enhanced.
- Updated IT and digital resources provision is in place.
