- Music Assemblies: Mr Thomas will be holding performance assemblies for his guitar and piano pupils on Tuesday 21st March and Wednesday 22nd March respectively see calendar below for details. - We are pleased to let you know that the booking system for **Easter Holiday Club** is now open; sessions can be booked via your online Scopay account. The club will run Monday to Thursday in the first week and Tuesday to Friday in the second week i.e. there will be no holiday club running on the Easter bank holiday weekend. The day runs from 8am until 5pm, with drop off between 8-8:30am and pickup 4:30-5pm. The cost is £30 per day for the first child and £20 thereafter for each sibling. This includes a morning and afternoon snack; children will need to bring their own packed lunch. Please note holiday club sessions are non-refundable.
- Please check the ingredients of any pesto sauce that you may be giving to your child in their lunchbox. Pesto often contains pine nuts, which are a type of tree seed and are therefore allowed in school. However any other nut ingredients are not permissible; we are a nut-free school and have several children with severe nut allergies
