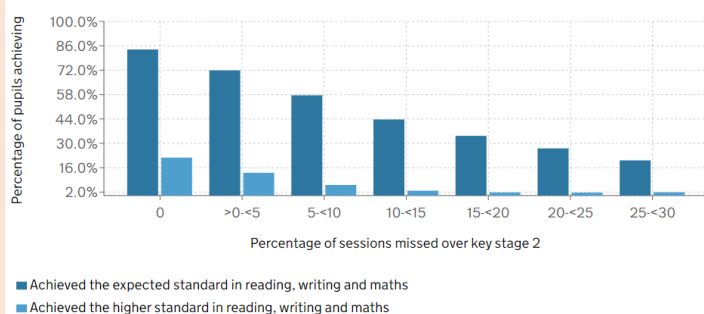

### School Notices

- We would like to remind you of the importance of good attendance. Data shows that pupils with higher attainment have lower levels of absence (source DfE):

Absence will not be authorised for holidays during term time. If 10 sessions of unauthorised absence (a session being a morning or an afternoon) are recorded in any 10 week rolling period Penalty Notices may be issued to each parent.

- If you have a 3 or 4-year old you may be entitled to 30 hours free childcare a week. Check if you are eligible at:

If your child turns 3 years old between 30<sup>th</sup> April and 31<sup>st</sup> August, the recommended time to apply is: 15<sup>th</sup> June to 31<sup>st</sup> July. The deadline for application for 30 hours childcare for the autumn term is 31<sup>st</sup> July. All 3 and 4 year olds are eligible for 15 hours free childcare; this does not require an application on this website.

- As the weather starts to improve, please remember to apply sun cream to your child before they come to school each morning. Every child should also have a water bottle and sun hat at school; children will be encouraged to wear these as required throughout the day.
