• Y3 parents: please note that **school lunches** are chargeable from Y3-6 inclusive, and also for Pre-School children. The current Hampshire price is £3 per day. Please login to your Scopay account to add credit to your account. We ask that you keep your child's balance in credit a tall times please.

• Please check your <u>class teacher's blog</u> for important updates on items your child will need in school for the next day, schedules of activities, homework and current topics being studied in the classroom:

• If your child suffers from sickness & diarrhea they will need to remain at home for **48 hours** following the final episode. Please respect this to prevent the spread of infection to others.

• If your address or **contact details** have changed during the past year and you have not already informed the school office, please email your new details as soon as possible. If you have a SIMS parent account, you will be able to log in and change these details directly.

• Parents of 3 & 4 year olds can apply for **30-hours free childcare** (All are entitled to 15 hours a week universal free childcare). You can apply from the time your child is 2 years and 36 weeks old. The deadline for applications to be ready for the spring term is: <u>31st December 2023</u>.

• Secondary school applications are open until <u>31st October</u>. Applications can be submitted <u>online</u>, while paper forms can be requested by emailing: admissions.team@hants.gov.uk.
