• We have been informed that HCC will be **increasing the price** of school meals to £3.00 on 5<sup>th</sup> June 2023. YR, Y1 and Y2 children will continue to receive Universal Free School Meals. If you are adding credit to your child's Scopay account please bear this price increase in mind. We respectfully ask that you keep your child's lunch account in credit at all times; as a school we are unable to carry any debt. Thank you for your understanding.

• If your child has any **food allergies** you will need to complete a medical special diet form if you have not done so already. This is required even if your child does not usually have school lunches. Please create an account and upload your medical evidence at:

• We regularly speak to the children in PSHE sessions about the importance of **online safety** including how to decide if a website or app is safe. Some children have spoken of using apps such as TikTok and Instagram; please be mindful that these (and other apps) have a 13 year old age limit. Children have also been made aware that online accounts should be set to private. Please continue to have these essential discussions with your children at home.
