Following a request from parents, we are trialling offering Y5/6 ponchos (like a beach towel) when they are changing for PE. Depending on success we may add to uniform list in the future.



• HCC have increased the cost of school lunches to £3 (from 5th June 2023), please take this into account when adding credit to your child's Scopay account. • If your child is in Y6, please log into your Scopay account to ensure all payments are up to date before they leave school at the end of this term. We also ask that you ensure your child's account remains in credit for school lunches until the end of term. If you have any questions or would like a print out of your account balance please contact the school office.
