How can you help at home?

- Times table fluency (TT Rockstars, Hit the Button, orally). The expectation is that children at the end of Year 4, are able to recall multiplication facts fluently for all times tables.
- Ed Shed homework – the set tasks follow what has been taught in school that week. This helps to embed the learning that has taken place in school.
- Check our weekly blogs – this will include the areas that have been taught that week and at times we signpost additional resources to access at home.



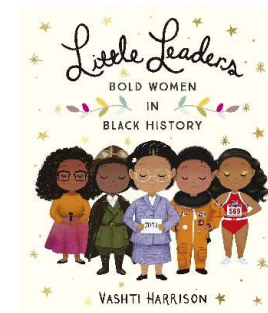
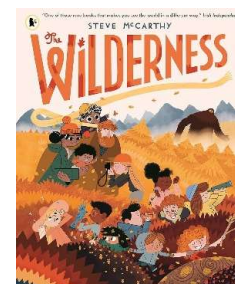

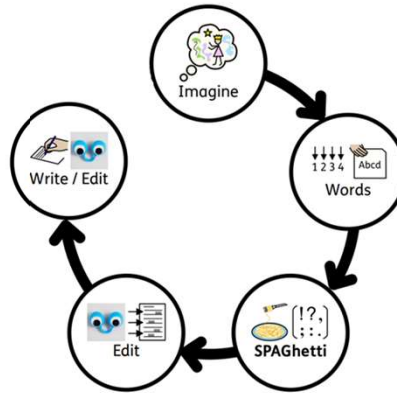
How can you help at home?
